Line Up Begins at 6:00 PM

(Approximate distance 1.1 miles)

**FIND YOUR GROUP NAME, LINE UP NUMBER AND THE LINE UP STREET
AT THE END OF THIS DOCUMENT**

- Do not come in off of Lilly Rd south From Fond Du Lac Ave. **The Lilly Road bridge west of Menomonee Ave is OUT**; you cannot reach Menomonee Ave.
- Do not attempt to enter Menomonee Ave from Pilgrim Rd or Appleton Ave to Line Up!
- **ENTER PARADE LINE UP AREA** from **Lilly Rd**, Proceed **west** On Menomonee Ave to your Line Up Street. Elm Lane And Manhattan Dr Are Across From The Church (See The Map For More Details).
- **NOTE:** Appleton Avenue will close at 5:30 PM

Interval Between Units:

Please **AVOID GAPS** in the parade. Units in front make sure your there's not a large gap between the 3 units by. Stay close to the unit in front of you. **Be careful that any performance you do does not stop the parade's flow.** Volunteers will be stationed along the parade route to help keep the parade moving. It is imperative that you keep pace with the unit ahead of you. **Walkers must stay within your group's area – not ahead or behind.**

Favors & Candy:

No favors, candy, etc are to be tossed from any moving vehicles, floats, or autos. Favors or candy may only be distributed at street level within 3' of the curb and must be handed to parade spectators. This is imperative. Any group NOT complying will be subject to removal from the parade and not invited back next year.

THE PARADE ENDS AT THE INTERSECTION OF MERRIMAC AND EASTWOOD DR..
(This intersection is located at the northeast corner of the High School)

ALL BANDS, BATON & DRUM CORPS OR ANY OTHER MUSICAL GROUP ARE REQUESTED TO CONTINUE PLAYING TO THE END AT THE INTERSECTION DESCRIBED ABOVE.

PLEASE DO NOT STOP AFTER TURNING OFF OF APPLETON, CONTINUE ALL THE WAY TO THE END.
